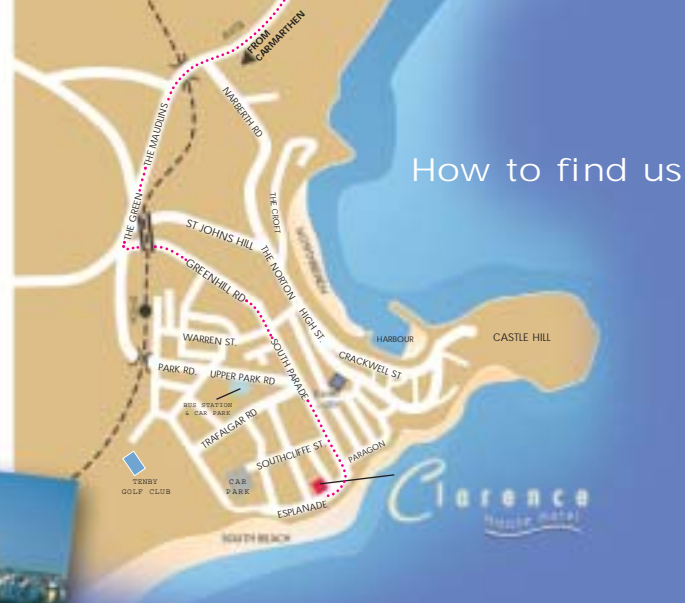


Local Amenities

The whole of the town centre with shops and entertainment is reached within a few minutes' walk on the level.

The Bowling Green is adjacent to the Hotel, and Tenby's Golf Club is a 10 minute walk from the hotel. The course is a classic Links course, running alongside the south Beach. In 2002 it was voted among the top 100 golf courses in Great Britain & Ireland. It is well worth a visit for golfers of all abilities.

The area also offers a wide variety of attractions for all the family, from Oakwood theme park, Folly Farm and The Dinosaur Experience - all great for children; to Heatherton Country Sports Park for the more energetic.



How to find us

When you reach the old town walls and trees, keep them on your left hand side past the Five Arches all the way to The Esplanade railings. Turn right to see the Clarence House Hotel as first in the middle block.

Stop by the front entrance for unloading.

Municipal car parks, railway station, bus station, Castle Hill and harbour are all within easy walking distance.

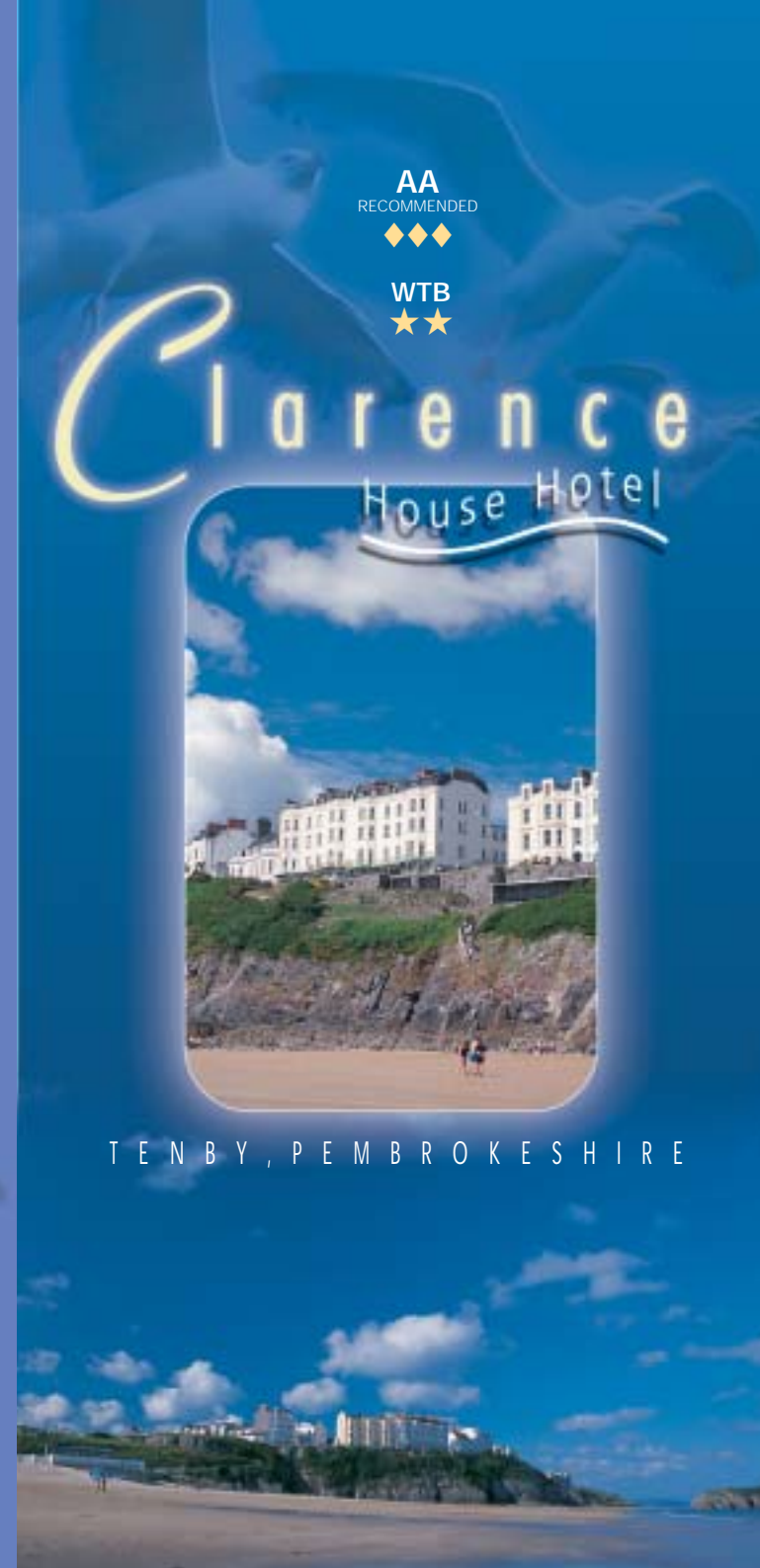
